There are a variety of transport options to get you to University Coventry Hospital.

Visitors and patients of University Hospital Coventry can enjoy a regular and convenient public transport service. This guide helps you find the best way to get to the hospital from Coventry and the wider West Midlands area.

NHS Patient Transport Service

Patients are required to make their own arrangements to travel to and from hospital. However, in some special circumstances, hospital transport may be available if you have a particular medical condition which stops you from using private or public transport and where it would be detrimental to your condition or recovery if you were not able to travel with the support of trained ambulance personnel, e.g. if you need to travel on a stretcher or you require continuous medical gases.

Ring and Ride

Ring and Ride is unable to take people to hospital appointments because the National Health Service Act states that people are entitled to access NHS Patient Transport Services in accordance with their eligibility criteria.

It can however transport people registered with the service to visit people in hospital. More information is available on audio tape, large print and printed leaflets in English and community languages at www.ringandride.org or call **0845 271 0455**.

Concessionary Passes

Older people who are eligible for an English National Concessionary Travel Pass - can travel free on the bus anywhere in England during 'off-peak' times. Off-peak times are between 9.30am and 11.00pm Monday to Friday, all day at weekends and on bank holidays.

To apply for a pass call **0845 303 6760**.

Individual bus operator day tickets are available and start from £3.00 (adult). Please ask individual operators for more details. Take a look at the different options and choose the one that suits you best.

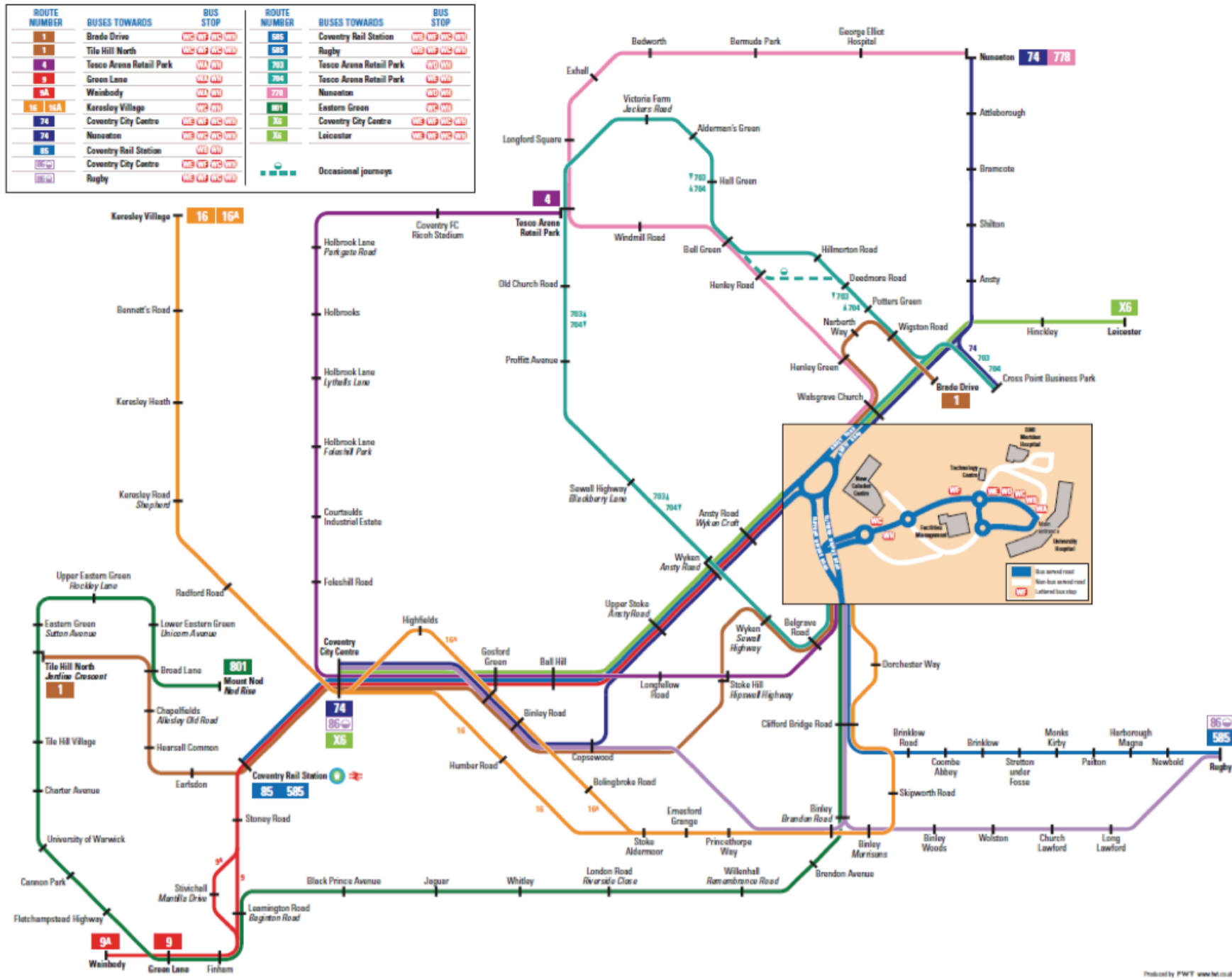
This off-peak ticket gives you unlimited travel on the bus, train and Metro across the Network West Midlands area for one day.
