Car Parking

The Trust is currently implementing a point-based system to allocate passes for University Hospital and the Hospital of St Cross. The new parking system will use automatic number plate recognition (ANPR) and is expected to go live in August 2017.

New applications are not currently accepted but new employees will soon be given the opportunity to apply on the system, this is likely to be May/June 2017.

FAQs

What is the cost of the car park? There is a flat rate of £40 per month for a standard pass. A £15 per month pass can be applied for by staff on 'rotating shifts', who are not offered a standard pass. This will allow them to park 'weekends only' or 'nights only'. Both can be purchased.

I work part time, how much will I be charged? There is one flat rate for all staff regardless of hours worked or salary paid.

How will payment be taken? Payment will be deducted from your salary.

I have on-call responsibility; will I be able to get an on-site space? Only if you meet other essential criteria.
