Mission statement

The department of Spiritual Care is an integral part of the University Hospitals Coventry and Warwickshire (UHCW) NHS Trust and comprises a multi-faith and multi-denominational team of Chaplains committed to supporting UHCW NHS Trust in its quest for a holistic approach to health care

The Chaplains in the Trust's hospitals are responsible for:-

- The provision and/or coordination of spiritual care to all patients, relatives and carers during their time in hospital.
- The provision of spiritual care to all staff employed by the Trust.
- The provision and/or coordination of spiritual, religious and cultural care to people of all faith and of none.
- The provision of an effective 24 hour, 365 day on call system utilising Anglican, Roman Catholic and Free Church members of the team.
- The provision of support to patients, relatives, carers and staff in situations where 'bad news' is being given or received, on request.

We understand that coming into hospital can be an unsettling experience and we want to make each patient's stay in hospital as easy as possible. In our work we depend on the consent of patients to be involved in their care and undertake to ensure that each patient's privacy, dignity and confidentiality is respected by us at all times.

In addition the team offers:

- Formal and informal incident debriefing for staff.
- Education and Training for staff in a range of areas related to support and communication skills.

Places of Worship

The Faith Centre, UHCW, Coventry

The Chaplaincy Team is located in the Faith Centre on the Ground Floor, West Wing. In the Faith Centre you will find a place of solace, quiet contemplation and reflection for people of all faiths and of none, as well as prayer rooms for Christians, Sikhs, Hindus and Muslims. There are also washrooms and Wudu facilities within the centre. You may also access a variety of Holy Books, some of which are bi-lingual.
