Your review appointment explained

Please bring this leaflet with you to your appointment

What will happen in the appointment?

We will have a look in your ears with a small light to see if you have any wax in your ears.



We will ask you questions about how you have been getting on with your hearing aids and how much you have been wearing them. We will check that they have not been too loud or too quiet for you to wear them. We will also make sure that they have not been making your ears sore when you do wear them.



Patient Information

We will put your hearing aids in a machine that will make sure that they are working well and will then get you to put them back in if you normally do this.

You may be shown some pictures of different places and you will be asked how well you hear in that place. You will be asked if you think that you can hear better with the hearing aids in than with no hearing aids.

Your appointment should last approximately 30 minutes
