Modern matron

Critical care has a Modern Matron (nursing manager), Isatu Kargbo. She wears a black and grey striped uniform. Although we aim to address any issues at ward level, please feel free to contact her with any problems or feed-back regarding critical care.

Senior Nurses

A team of senior nurses work with the Modern Matron and they can be identified by a navy blue uniform. They are all involved with patient care in addition to management duties.

Health Care Support Workers also work in each area and they wear maroon uniforms.

Ward Clerks

We have three ward clerks based in the reception area, they wear navy blue uniforms with green dots and will guide you regarding visiting the unit. Critical care is very fortunate to also benefit from several volunteers who will help you during visiting hours.
