Outpatient Prescriptions – New Dispense and Delivery service

The hospital is now offering a Dispense and Delivery service that will give you a choice of where and how you can collect your medicine if you are an outpatient.

You may have been prescribed medicine during your appointment. You will be given a white hospital prescription at the clinic and asked to take it to the on-site Lloyds Outpatient Pharmacy. This is on the ground floor of the hospital near the front entrance.

At the Pharmacy you will be offered a choice of collecting your medicine from a local branch of Lloyds Pharmacy, where you will be able to pick up your medication at your own convenience. Please allow **48 hours** after your appointment for your prescription to arrive at your chosen branch. It will be held at your chosen branch for seven days.

You will be given a request card by the Outpatient Pharmacy which you must present to your local Lloyds Pharmacy to collect your medication.

Where your medicine is needed urgently, you will still have the option to wait at the Hospital Pharmacy for your prescription to be dispensed.

Why am I being encouraged to collect from my local community Lloyds Pharmacy?

This is a new service designed to reduce the amount of time you have to spend on the hospital site, which is important as we try to maintain social distancing. It will also reduce the waiting time for your medication. For most prescriptions you

are now able to collect your dispensed medication closer to your home, at a time which is convenient for you.

The flow chart on the next page shows how to obtain your prescribed medicine following your outpatient appointment.

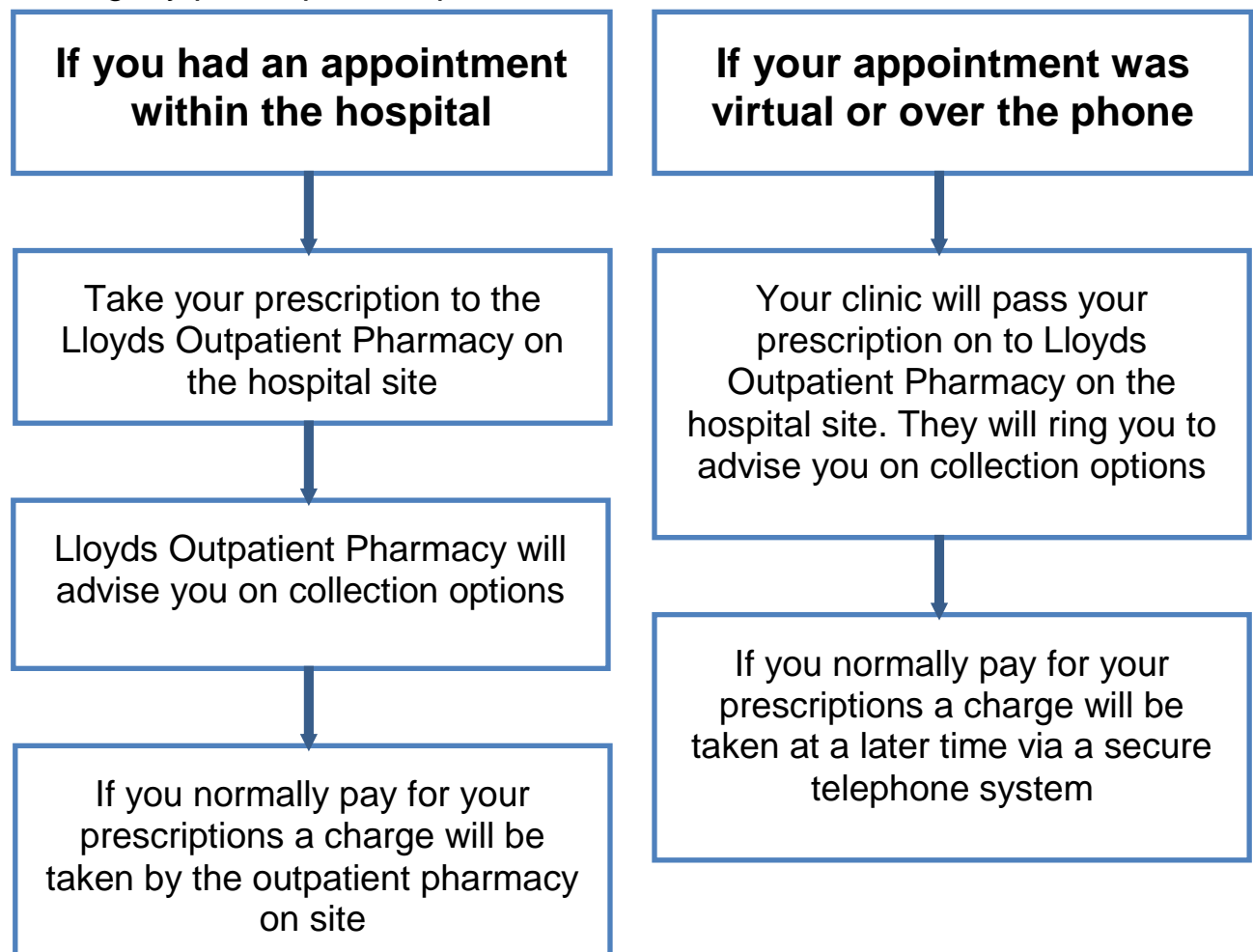

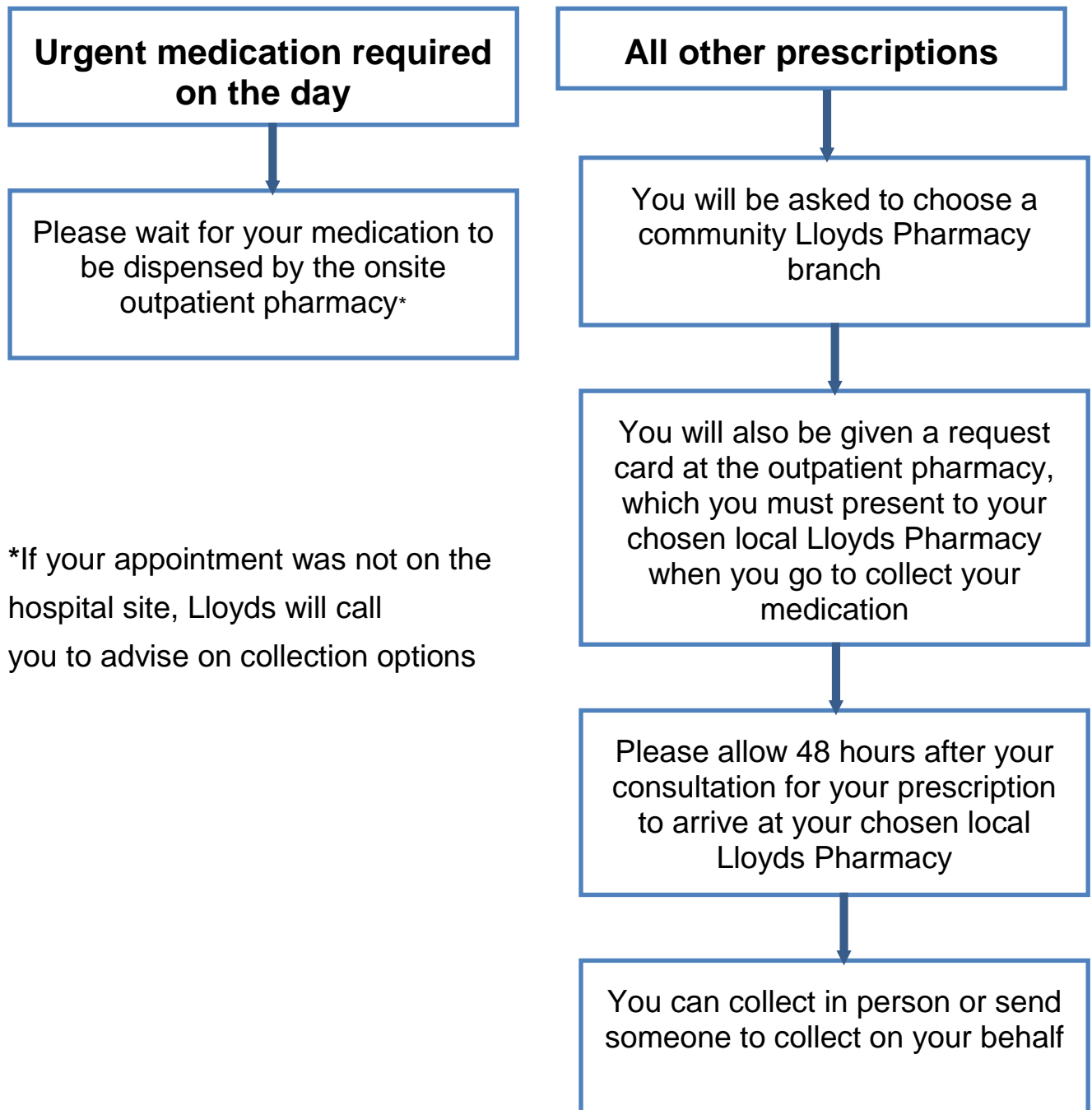
