If you have had IV contrast medium:

- Ensure you drink at least two to three litres of fluid over the next 24 hours following the procedure
- In the unlikely event that you experience any delayed allergic symptoms (skin rash) within 48 hours following your injection of contrast, please contact your GP for advice
- Please also inform the Radiotherapy Department so that details of the reaction can be noted in your records
- Sometimes the vein used for the injection collapses and some of the injected contrast may leak into the tissues during the injection. This is usually absorbed into the tissues with no ill effect, **however if you experience any redness or blistering of the arm over the next few days, please contact your GP urgently. If you are unable to contact your GP go to A&E. Take this leaflet with you and hand to the attending doctor.**



Patient Information

Diabetic patients with known or suspected renal impairment

- **You should have stopped taking NSAIDS**, as advised in the preparation instructions; you may recommence taking them the day following the procedure. Use paracetamol as a substitute for pain relief until then.

Breastfeeding

If you have had an IV contrast medium and you are breastfeeding, you should wait for 24 hours after your scan before you resume.
