Information for you: Cancer of the liver, pancreas or bile duct

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Essential information about your type of cancer and treatment has been provided by your clinical nurse specialist. However you and your family may require additional information about various aspects of cancer and the effect it has on daily life. This leaflet tells you about the information available and where to find it.

Titles available from the Cancer Information and Support Centre

The Macmillan Cancer Information and Support Centre, situated in the main entrance of University Hospital, Coventry holds a wide range of information about all aspects of cancer including:

- General information about cancer as well as leaflets about specific cancers
- Treatment information e.g. Radiotherapy and Chemotherapy including individual and combination chemotherapy regimes
- Healthy eating, eating problems and weight management for those with cancer
- Benefit, grant and financial information including contact details or referral to your local Macmillan Citizen Advice Bureau
- Information about your rights at work for patients and carers
- Coping with side effects – fatigue, hair loss, body changes and emotions
- How to talk about your cancer, talking to children when an adult has cancer, and for friends and carers how to talk to someone with cancer
- Cancer and older people, cancer and younger patients and carers
- Cancer and the effect on relationships and sexuality
- Cancer and complementary therapies
- Information for carers when someone has advanced cancer
- Discharge from hospital to home, making treatment decisions and many more
