# **Acute Oncology Service**

This leaflet tells you about the Acute Oncology Service and how to contact us.

#### What is Acute Oncology?

We provide telephone advice to patients who develop symptoms from their cancer or associated treatment.

Any query is dealt with by an experienced oncology / haematology nurse.

Based on a telephone assessment, we may:

- Advise you on how to manage your symptoms at home
- Arrange for you to be assessed as an outpatient by the acute oncology team
- Ask you to see your GP or another community healthcare provider
- Ask you to attend A&E for urgent attention

Advice is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

If there is no answer at the time of your call, please leave a message. We will get back to you as soon as we can.



#### **Patient Information**

If you are experiencing any of the following symptoms, dial 999 or attend A&E:

- Chest pain
- Severe difficulty in breathing
- Uncontrolled bleeding
- You have a temperature higher than 38° and have had chemotherapy in the last 6 weeks

If you are having chemotherapy or immunotherapy, you'll be provided with an **alert card(s)**. Always carry this with you. The Acute Oncology Nurses contact details are also on the backs of these cards.

If you are admitted to hospital at any point during your treatment, please present the alert card to the team looking after you.
