Step-down plan for laryngopharyngeal (silent) reflux medications

Step 1

Take a **high dose** of your **proton pump inhibitor (PPI)** 30 minutes before breakfast and before your evening meal for **2 months**.

Also, take 10ml of Gavascon Advance after meals and last thing at night.

The high dose of your **proton pump inhibitor (PPI)** is listed below:

- Pantoprazole 40mg
- Lansoprazole 30mg
- Omeprazole 40mg
- Esomeprazole 40mg
- Rabeprazole 20mg

Step 2

Take a **low dose** of your **PPI** 30 minutes before breakfast and before your evening meal for **2 months**.

Also, take 10ml of Gavascon Advance after meals and last thing at night.

Your low dose is half the dose you took in step 1.

Step 3

Take a **low dose** of your **PPI** 30 minutes before your evening meal for **2** months.

Also, take 10ml of Gavascon Advance after meals and last thing at night.

Your low dose is half the dose you took in step 2.

Step 4

Stop using your PPI regularly. Use your PPI when required, such as when going out for a meal at a restaurant.

Take 10ml of Gavascon Advance after meals and last thing at night.

Continue to take 10ml of Gaviscon Advance for at least 2 weeks after stopping PPI. This is to reduce the chance of rebound symptoms.

After 2 weeks, Gaviscon Advance may be taken at night on a long-term basis.
