# Adult shared care Ocular Motility Service - non eye casualty referrals

You are being seen in the Adult Shared-Care Ocular Motility Service which deals with patients with eye movement problems. The shared care occurs between the Orthoptic Team and Miss Dean, Consultant Ophthalmologist.

The service is set up to resolve your eye movement problems as promptly and safely as possible. Not all patients with eye movement problems will need to see Miss Dean but will be seen by the Orthoptists who are specialised in treating eye movement problems.

You will be booked into Miss Dean's clinic if your case is considered to be outside the remit of the Orthoptist.

Some patients who require surgery will have a series of Orthoptic measurements performed over a number of months. Miss Dean's decisions about surgery cannot be made until these measurements are stable.
