Discharge Advice Following Your Intravitreal Injection

Please obtain a repeat prescription from your GP for your next injection

Instil drops 2 hourly on the day of the injection and the following day. The times stated are a guide only. These are lubricating drops to keep your eye moistened and comfortable after exposure to the disinfectant, which is the “nasty stuff”, essential to minimise the risk of infections. You may adjust the frequency of Celluvisc to more or less frequent use according to how comfortable is your eye.

- Do not rub your eye for 24 hours
- Expect your eye to be red and gritty for a few days due to the disinfectant



Patient Information

- ☑ Expect your eye to be a little painful. Take painkillers to relieve this
- ☑ If you see black bubbles or spots after the injection these will disappear after a few days
- ☑ Make sure to wash your hands before using your eye drops
- ☑ Ensure that you keep your eye drops in a clean cupboard
- ☑ Use clean tissue to wipe your eye
- ☑ Avoid swimming for a week
- ☑ Avoid the use of eye make up for a few days

Attend casualty or ring for advice if your eye:

- ☑ Is very painful or if the pain increases the day after the injection instead of being less painful
- ☑ The eye is sticky and you notice a coloured discharge
- ☑ You notice a shower of black spots or a shadow /cobweb in your vision
