Eye Surgery: Overnight Stay - Local Anaesthetic/Sedation

You are soon to be admitted for your eye surgery.

You will be advised of the ward details when contacted to book your surgery date

- Please follow the starving instructions given in your letter.
- If you have not been advised to omit your medication you should take your normal dose with a small amount of water.
- Please have a bath or shower before admission.
- Please wear clean loose fitting clothing.
- Do not wear make-up, jewellery or nail varnish.
- Do not bring valuables with you as the hospital cannot be responsible for their safety.

Special instructions

Things to bring with you:

- Dressing gown
- Slippers
- Cotton pants
- Toiletries
- Pyjamas / night-dress
- Medication and Eye drops
- Glasses
