Live kidney donation – Tests for potential kidney donors from overseas

The following is a list of tests required for potential kidney donors from overseas.

Blood tests:

- Blood group
- Urea Electrolytes and Creatinine
- Liver function tests
- Full blood count
- Blood glucose
- Cholesterol
- Virology to include Hepatitis B & C, CMV, Varicella Zoster, Syphilis, HIV and EBV

Other tests:

- Urinalysis for blood and protein
- MSU (mid stream urine for cell count and culture)
- Renal ultrasound scan
- Blood pressure taken on three different occasions
- Chest X-ray
