

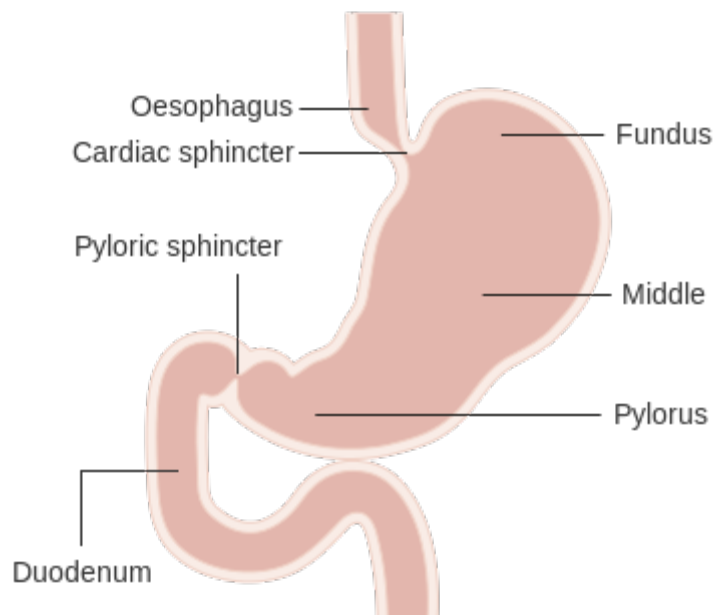

# Following your Endoscopy

### Introduction

Today you have had an endoscopy and have been informed that there is an area of concern in the upper part of your digestive tract.

The diagram below indicates where this area is:

Tissue samples (biopsies) **have / have not** been taken today and will be reviewed in the Upper GI Multi-Disciplinary Team meeting (MDT).



## Patient Information

A CT scan of your chest, abdomen and pelvis **will / will not** be arranged for you if necessary.

## Your Results

Your test results will be discussed the following week by our specialist team at our MDT meeting.

An out-patient appointment will be arranged for you following the review of your biopsy /CT scan, if appropriate. You will be informed of your test results at this appointment and you will have an opportunity to discuss a management / treatment plan. A relative or friend can accompany you to this appointment.
