To improve the support for patients with Upper Gastrointestinal disease, University Hospitals Coventry & Warwickshire NHS Trust has two Specialist Nurses to act as advisers for both patients and their carers.

Which group of patients does this cover?

All patients with oesophageal (gullet) or gastric (stomach) cancer, and some patients that do not have a cancer but need specialist advice.

Who are we?

Gail Goddard and Vikki Nunn have specialist knowledge and are experienced in caring for patients with oesophageal or gastric conditions.

How can we help?

We provide information and advice on your condition and can discuss investigations, procedures, and treatment options.

If surgery is indicated, we will explain to you what to expect before and after the operation and support you during your stay in hospital.
