The role of the PDSN is to support children, young people and their families living with diabetes, and understand what each of them needs.

PDSNs can support you in and outside of hospital, in a place that suits you. This helps the child or young person live a regular life, reach their full potential, have the same opportunities as others, and lower diabetes-related risks.
