Renal Dietetics Team

Scope of Care

- The renal dietician specialises in assessing nutritional requirements and food intake to renal (kidney) patients.
- Individually tailored advice is provided based on blood results, whether a patient is receiving dialysis or not and medical condition.
- Dieticians work with patients who have kidney problems to keep them in the best nutritional status possible, in times of both health and illness.
- The renal dietician works to reduce or remove the risk of malnutrition.
- Renal diets are complex and require patient education.
- An experienced renal dietician is essential for the development of effective patient information relating to diet.
- The dietician works as part of the multidisciplinary team. This enables referrals to be made to other professionals (for example doctors, nurses, social workers and counsellors) who are involved with other aspects of patient care in order to achieve nutritional requirements.

Scope of care

Ensure patients are entered onto the correct access pathway following referral to the team.

To support patients through their chosen access journey

- Facilitate Access clinics
- List patients for their access procedures
- List patients for their renal biopsies
- Arrange and list patients for their fistulogram/plasty procedures
- Arrange for patients to be assessed and prepared for their procedures by attending anaesthetic reviews and pre op.
- Ensure patients fistulas are monitored for maturation
- Escalate any access/fistula problems
- Ensure access surveillance maintained
- Arrange for fistula/graft salvage

Renal Clinical Psychology

Scope of Care

The Clinical Psychologist offers psychological assessment and intervention for renal patients, their carers and families, who have difficulties in the psychological adjustment to illness, or significant and sustained distress arising from illness, including:

- Anxiety
- Depression
- Specific phobias
- Trauma reactions
- Difficulties in adjusting to and coping with care regimes and treatments
- Associated behavioural and habit problems
- Assessment of difficulties, followed by signposting to appropriate services, advice to individual or team, and in some cases one-to-one psychological intervention
- In addition, clinical supervision, consultation, and training is provided for direct care staff, as well as conducting research, audit and service evaluation.
