Introduction

Ward 30 comprises of 30 beds and is managed by Suzanne Blakeman.

Each patient will be allocated a consultant on arrival to the ward. Please inform the ward staff if you are already known to a respiratory consultant. If at any point you wish to speak to a doctor you can:

- Arrange with the nursing staff to see a junior doctor on the ward
- Make an appointment with the secretary to see the consultant
- Liaise with the nurse in charge to make an appointment for you

If you have any queries or concerns throughout your stay, please speak to one of the clinical sisters or the ward manager who will be happy to assist you.
